- 1 What prior learning will students need to access today's lesson successfully?
- 2 What prerequisite knowledge might some students have only partially developed?
- 3 What connection could you make explicit to help students see today's learning as part of a bigger instructional story?

Supports

- 1 Where are students most likely to struggle in this lesson, and why?
- 2 What misconception or incorrect strategy are you most likely to see?
- 3 What question could you ask that moves student thinking forward without doing the thinking for them?



DETERMINE

Learning

- 1 What evidence will convince you that students understand, not just that they got the correct answer?
- 2 At what point during the lesson do you most need to check student understanding?
- 3 What will you look or listen for that reveals how students are thinking?

- 1 If students show partial understanding, what might your next instructional move be?
- 2 What evidence would cause you to adjust your plan during the lesson?
- 3 How will you decide who needs reteaching, additional practice, or greater challenge?
